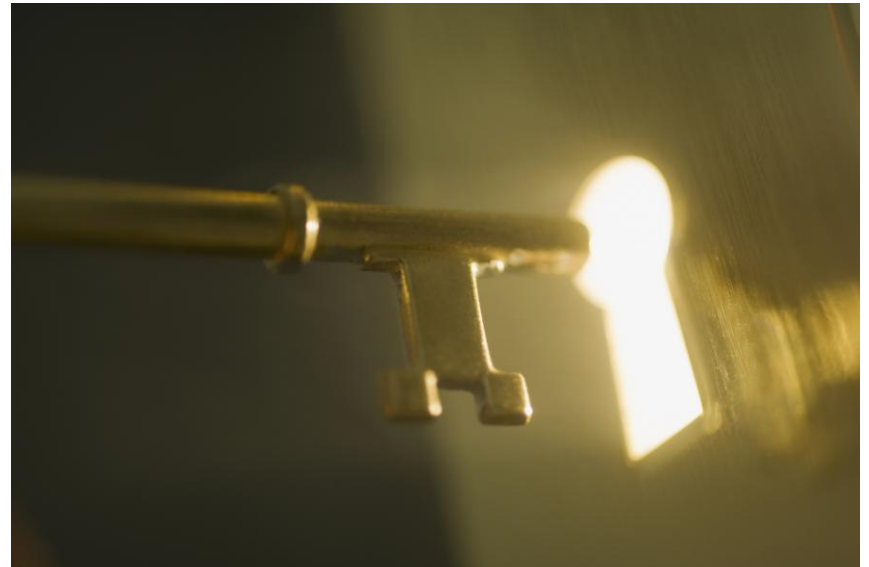

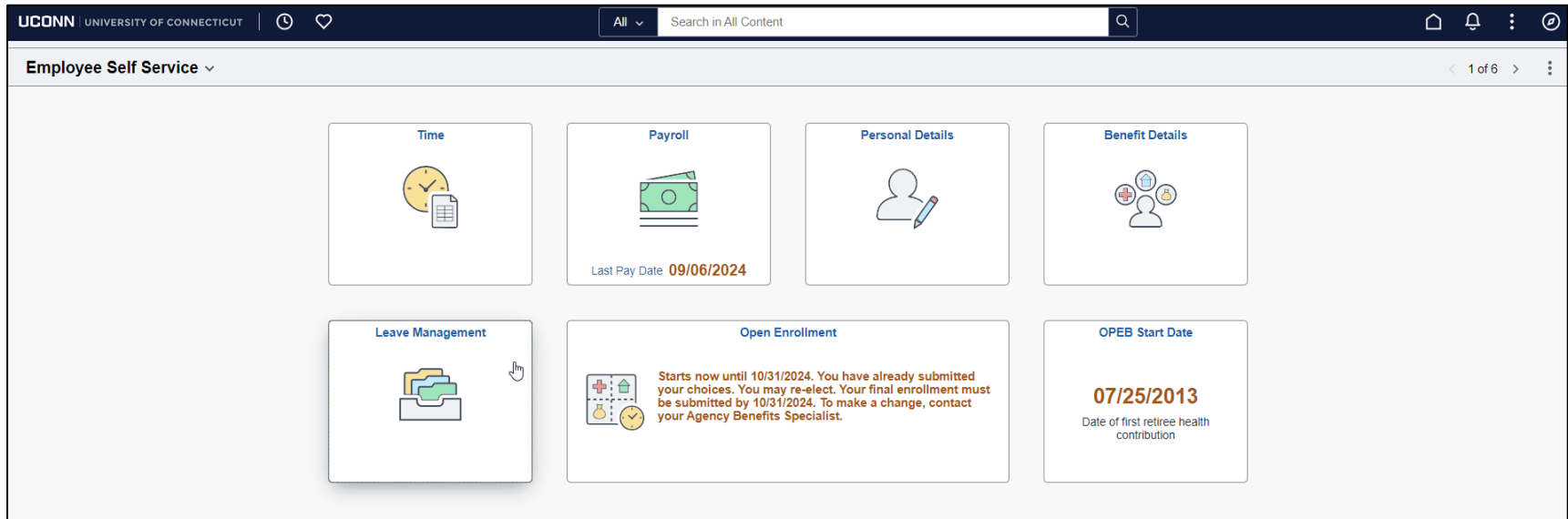

Homepage Drop-Down Menu & Navigator

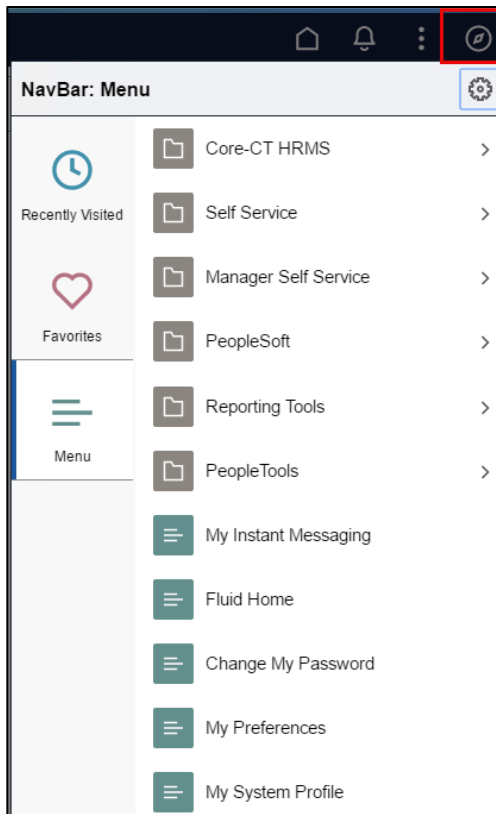

Access to homepages is role based.

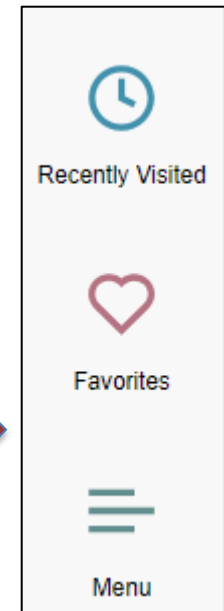
NavBar

The NavBar allows users to access additional functionality not contained within the homepages and tiles.



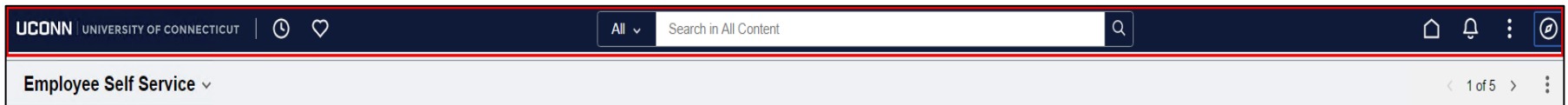
Access to pages within the NavBar is role based.

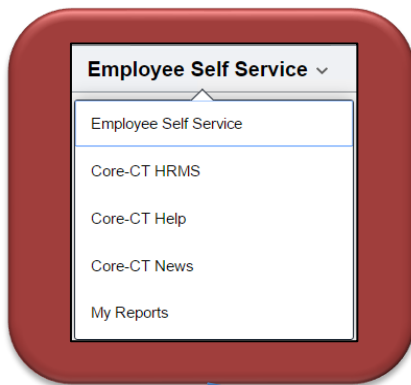
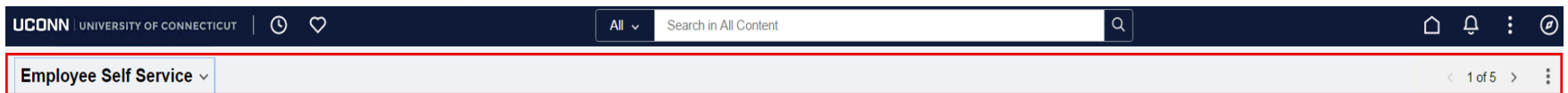

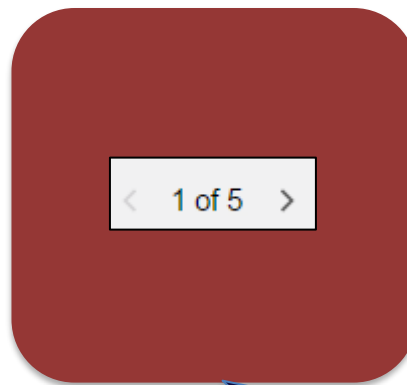


Banner Options: Dashboard View

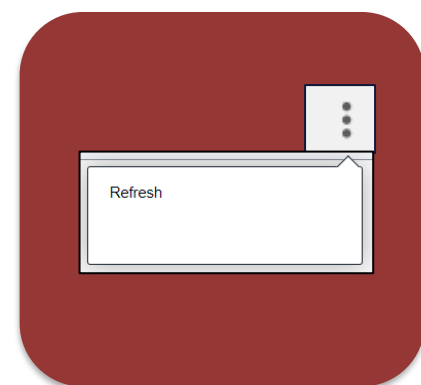
The Dashboard Banner provides additional navigation options



Homepage Drop-down allows users to navigate between homepages.



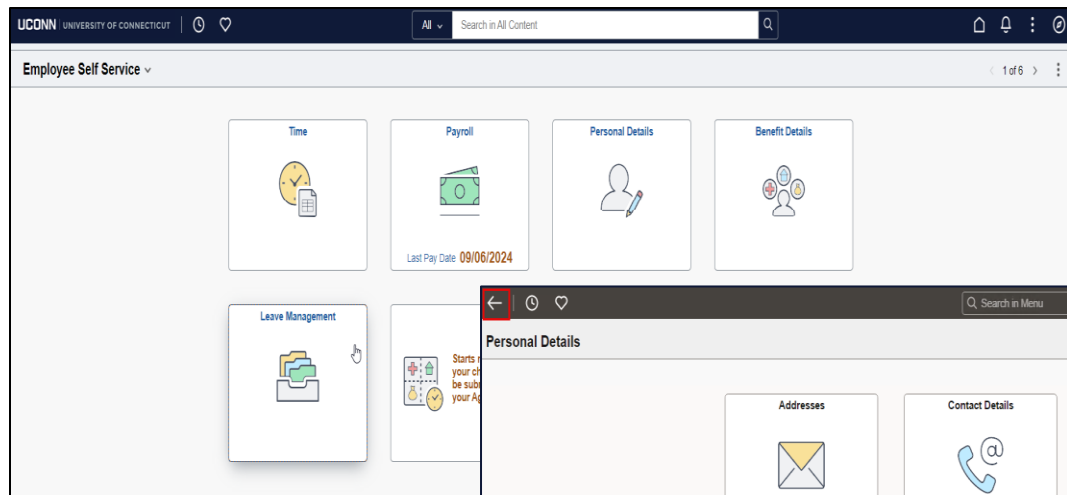
Homepage Navigator allows users to scroll through available homepages.



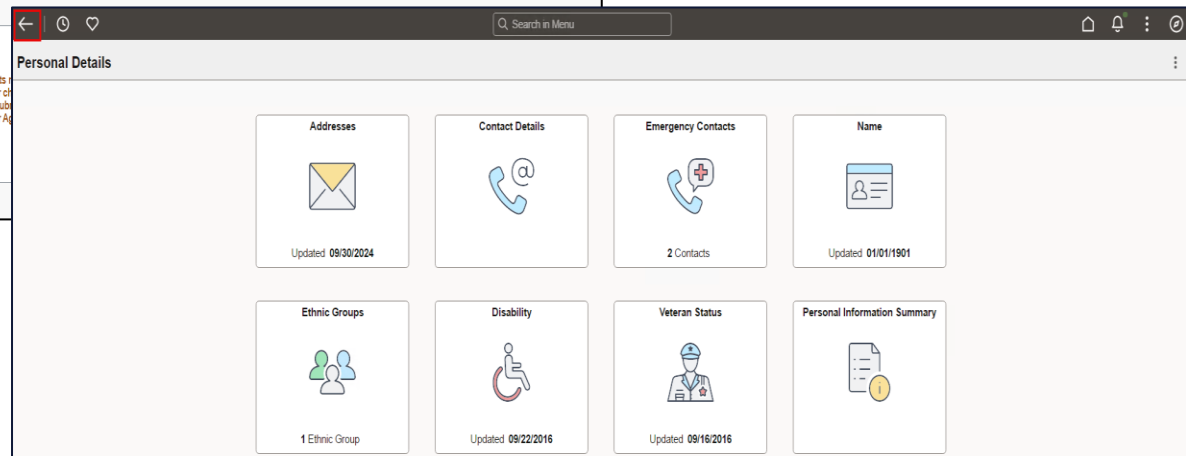
Homepages can be refreshed here.

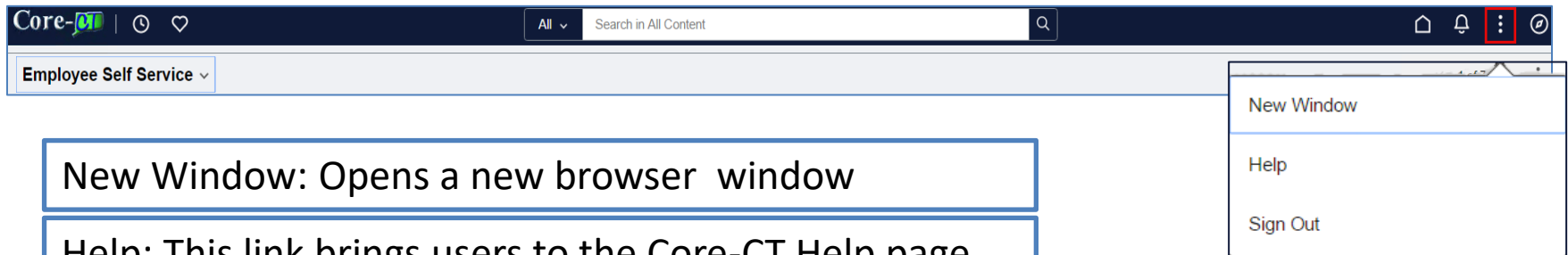


Tile Dashboard

Glossary

Dashboard – A dashboard is a specific module page, that organizes functionality, which can be accessed via a tile.

Fluid – Fluid is a standard interface that provides users with the ability to access applications in a variety of ways, including smartphones, tablets, desktops and laptops.

Fluid Banner – A standard banner appears at the top of every fluid page. The Fluid banner provides access to buttons such as favorites, home, and other options.

Fluid Pages – Fluid pages are a new interface that adds tiles to homepages for navigation instead of cascading pagelets or menus. Fluid is a responsive user interface that works on desktops, tablets, and phones.

Homepage – Homepages are the starting point for navigation in Fluid. The Employee Self-Service (ESS) is the default homepage that displays after login. Users will use the homepage drop down to navigate to different homepages based on their roles.

Global Search – Global search is useful to perform keyword-based searches.

NavBar – The NavBar can be found on the fluid banner and provides access to the classic, non-Fluid navigation.

Tiles – Tiles are interactive buttons found on Fluid homepages and dashboards. When clicked, they link to common business transactions and high action functionality.
